In the BEPS project (Base Erosion and Profit Shifting), the OECD is working on 15 work streams to develop the new rules of international corporate taxation. Country-by-country reporting, Permanent Establishment, Transfer Pricing and other key elements of this project will fundamentally change the way corporates will be taxed in their international business.

At the same time, there are frequent discussions about a reform of the US corporate taxes which could in the coming years change the economic basis of Foreign Direct Investments.

Our Guest of Honor Robert B. Stack will give us an overview of the latest developments and help us understand what these developments mean for tax practitioners and the internationally active companies.

Bob Stack is the Deputy Assistant Secretary for International Tax Affairs in the Office of Tax Policy at the US Department of the Treasury. In this capacity, he is responsible, on behalf of the Assistant Secretary, for the conduct of legal and economic aspects of tax policy relative to the representation of the United States in bilateral and multilateral relations with other countries. Prior to joining Treasury, Bob Stack served as head of the international tax practice group at the law firm of Ivins, Phillips & Barker. In the private sector, he has over 26 years of experience in international tax matters. He graduated from Georgetown University Law Center in 1984, where he was editor-in-chief of the Georgetown Law Journal.
